## Licensure Update

The summer has been busy for the Legislative Committee of ILABA and we are pleased to share our progress with you! As many legislators headed to summer break, we knew that a slower schedule in Springfield could work to our advantage. Namely, it allowed us to build a strategy plan for the summer that could carry us forward when legislative session begin in the fall. At the heart of our legislative summer plan, we wanted to share the profession of ABA – what do we do on a daily basis, what do our services look like, and who do we serve in the community. As knowledge of ABA grows, the need for licensure becomes more apparent.

To kick-off this initiative, in June a survey was sent to all membership to request volunteers to join the effort. Once the group was identified, next steps were rolled out - designing support materials and trainings, agendas for meetings, lining up schedules, and using social media to disseminate information. In July, a series of 1-hour training meetings were held with interested Behavior Analysts in the state of Illinois. The agenda covered (a) discussing the profession of ABA, (b) importance of licensure, (c) setting up and conducting meetings with legislators, and (d) next steps. Working closely with the ILABA lobbyist, meetings with legislators were scheduled to discuss the profession of ABA. Meetings included BCBA constituents living/ working in the legislative district, an ILABA Legislative Committee member, and the ILABA lobbyist. Meetings ranged from 30 minutes to well over an hour of thoughtful discussion. To date, ILABA and the supporting volunteer group of BCBAs have scheduled over 15 meetings with legislators, across the state, for August and September, with even more in the works!

As we continue to work on licensure in Illinois, we would like to thank our volunteer group of BCBAs. This monumental progress wouldn't be possible without a truly collaborative spirit. If you are interested in taking a more active role in legislative activities with ILABA, please reach out via email. We could use your help as we work towards making 2019 the year of licensure in the state of Illinois!
